

### Workgroup Name:

CTN Legislative Workgroup

#### Purpose:

- Serve as a media for the communication of activities at the national, state and local levels.
- Educate Trauma Program members, other Colorado organizations, and elected officials of the need for legislation that supports improved access to resources for continued quality trauma care for all patients.
- Promote community and elected officials' awareness of issues related to trauma.

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#### Rationale:

- Need for more legislative awareness and support of trauma care and trauma systems from state and local levels.
- Need for improved education and awareness of legislative actions among Trauma Program members that impact trauma care within Colorado.

#### Time Frame:

- Workgroup chairperson, and if deemed necessary the co-chairperson, will be appointed per CTN bylaws.
- Committee to begin 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2019.

#### Tasks/Timeline/Deliverables:

- Develop and provide legislative resources for Trauma Program members to utilize within their own regions.
- Promote a culture of empowerment among Trauma Program members to participate in changes at the legislative level.
- Keep minutes of all discussions during meetings.
- Meet monthly to discuss legislative updates from various organizations and plan of action within Colorado Trauma Network.
- Organize Colorado Trauma Network to participate in Colorado Healthcare Day at the Capitol annually.
- Update Colorado Trauma Network website with meeting minutes, legislative changes, and calls to action.

# Communication/Sharing of results:

- Will report discussions and updates at quarterly Colorado Trauma Network meetings.
- Will report out at Bi-annual Colorado Trauma Network Conferences.
- Meeting minutes will be posted per Colorado Trauma Network bylaws.

#### Resources:

- Support of workgroups legislative goals with executive board input
- Access to Colorado Trauma Network website to share meeting minutes and legislative updates.

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#### Workgroup Membership:

Any paid member of Colorado Trauma Network may be a member of CTN Legislative workgroup.

#### **Non-CTN Members:**

#### Other codes-and why not to choose them

V00.83 Accident with motorized mobility V00.838 scooter

The word "mobility" has specific meaning as for the type of scooter that is being used at the time of the injury



V00.89 Accident on other pedestrian conveyance

This code is more general than the previously mentioned V00.18 as it removes the word "rolling" from the injury mechanism





#### Other codes-and why not to choose them

V87.8 other specified noncollision transport accidents involving motor vehicle (traffic)

Question whether the event involved a collision or not?

V00.141 Other scooter
V00.142 (nonmotorized)
V00.148
V00.381 Other flatbottom
v00.382 pedestrian

conveyance

V00.388

Negates the power of the motor




