#1 CTN Legislative Priority 2020

Stop the Bleed training & kits required in all traditional public schools

▪ Action Items

- Partner with American College of Surgeons, RETAC legislative members & other organizations within Colorado
- Cost analysis complete by COT Legislative Sub - Committee
- Bills already drafted from other states- thoroughly exhausted avenues that other states used to fund this program
- Develop CTN STB Toolkit
 - Teach STB at the Capitol once approved & dated established (done under COT subcommittee lead by Kerry Borrego)
 - Letter to legislators supporting the proposed bill once authored (not complete at his time as we do not have an authored bill)
 - Include resources from BleedingControl.org in legislative letter
- Develop Stop the Bleed Day in Colorado-tack on to National Stop the Bleed Day which is May 21st, 2020
