	Collaborative Falls Prevention Efforts	The committee reviewed the findings of contact with various organizations on falls prevention surveys completed. The consensus was that no surveys had been found specific to this issue. There was an older adult assessment done through the state which had a couple of falls prevention questions. There is also a State Plan on Aging FY 2019 – 2023. The committee feels we need more support from the state so Laurie will research some contacts through the state plan to reach out to about our efforts and how we might collaborate. Holly shared the efforts happening in Summit County around their community assessment and reviewing of data. Robert and Jasmine shared their efforts around creating open ended survey questions to determine fall prevention needs in their area.
