Advocacy Day (Grace)

- March 24, 2022
- Met with 2 Representative Offices & 2 Senate Offices
 - o Representative Offices: Lauren Boebert & Joe Neguse
 - O Senate Offices: John Hickenlooper & Michael Bennet
- Educate officials bout what we do and why it is important
- Asks
 - Sign 'Dear Colleague' letter for increased funding for:
 - Core State Injury Prevention program (Core SVIPP) only 23 of 50 states currently receiving funding
 - Elderly Falls Prevention
 - National Violent Death Reporting System (NVDRS)
- Results
 - House 'Dear Colleague' Letter
 - Over 50 signatures with 2 Colorado Reps signed
 - Joe Neguse & Jason Crow
 - Senate 'Dear Colleague' Letter
 - Currently circulating deadline is May 18th
- Missy co-chairs the ATS legislative committee
 - She has a toolkit on how to start

Overview of Falls Prevention Activities with Chelsea (South Metro Fire)

- Majority of elder falls & lift assists were happening in the home and not in community setting
- South Metro would love to market their classes with our discharges to help with recidivism
- Targeting caregivers for older adults at risk of falls
- For data collection, they are collecting contact info and have the individual fill out a survey asking if they can be contacted in 6mo for follow up
- Have had 10-15 registrants/class since Feb for older adults class
- Have had 4-5 registrants/class for Caring for older adults class

Injury Prevention Day (November)

- The Injury Free Coalition is creating a media toolkit so maybe we will wait to see what they do and go off of that
 - Not sure when that will be done

Falls Prevention Week (September)

- Lauren shared that it was a lot of work to get this together when they did it a couple of years ago. Some of the lessons learned include:
 - o It took a long time to get a website on their facility's page
 - They wish they would have started earlier
 - Gotten the word out to partners earlier
 - Finalized the passport earlier
- Ideas:
 - Have physical forms AND have PDF/virtual forms
 - Simplify it
 - Rather than a specific event at a specific location, have very general challenges (EX: attend a falls prevention class rather than attend the falls prevention class at (enter specific location)
 - Show pictures of prizes on the passport
 - Can we track visitors to page for IP?
 - o Will CTN pay for the giveaways?
 - 4-5 big prizes rather than goody bags for everyone who participates
 - Get other generations involved (kids/grandkids)
- Challenge Ideas:
 - Watch videos on falls prevention
 - Teach your friend an exercise
 - Have a convo with a friend
 - Signing up for Nymbl
- Need to get something out ASAP
 - Come up with a blurb about it that we can send to partnering entities/drop off locations
- Let's start thinking about future years too with this how we can partner, etc
- Media/radio plugs
- Bi-weekly meeting
