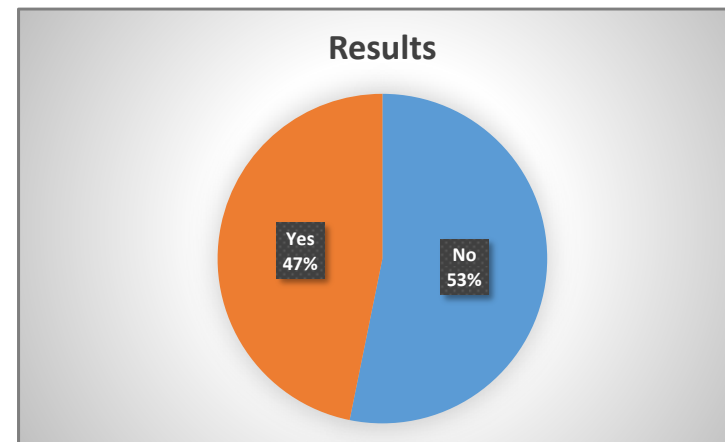


## The Most Missed Question

A 16YO M arrives to your facility after falling approx. 6ft out of a tree and hitting his head on the (25 points) ground. +LOC for about 30 seconds. Pt is now GCS of 14 with some confusion but following commands. A CT scan of the head is ordered while the patient is in the ED. The results of the CT Head read: "R frontoparietal subdural hematoma up to 6mm thick. No mass effect. Leftward shift of 5mm."

- D. N/A

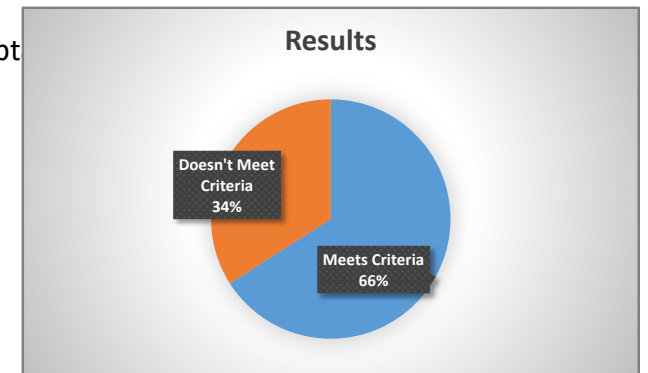



## A Close Second

## TQIP Benchmarking Inclusion Criteria

### Patient-Level Criteria (must meet all of the following)

- Age 16 years or older
- Trauma type of blunt or penetrating
- Injured patients with at least one AIS =3 or greater
- ED discharge disposition AND hospital discharge disposition can not be unknown
- Exclude patients with ED discharge disposition of home, home with services, transfer to another hospital, other, or left against medical advice.
- Exclude patients with pre-existing advance directives to withhold life-sustaining measures.
